The History Of PACES

PACES began in January 1972 with five parents and four professionals in the medical field. The original goal was to support and publicize Lamaze prepared childbirth. The first service to parents was a Mother's Helpline, which began in June, 1972, providing non-medical information and emotional support to parents.

1975 - The first Motherhood Seminar was held on a trial basis, later to be added to the growing list of PACES services. In September the first Board of Professional Consultants was organized.

1978 - The Childbirth Education Development Program was approved and certified as an official ICEA Childbirth Education Training Center. PACES was a recipient of the W. Clement Stone Foundation grant for organizational planning, and a long-range planning committee was organized.

1979 - Three geographic regions (East-Oak Park/Berwyn, Central-LaGrange/Hinsdale, and West-Downers Grove/Naperville) were established to better serve PACES growing membership. The book *How to Grow a Parent Group*, written by three PACES members, was published.

1982 - The Kids in Safe Seats (KISS) car seat rental program began. PACES also started offering the "How to Talk" workshops developed by Faber and Mazlish, child development experts.

1983 - A new region was developed to cover the Palos/Orland area. PACES sponsored hearing screening programs for children 3 years of age and younger and held its first Preschool Fair (which is now referred to as a Preschool Forum).

1992 - The Adoptive Parents and Working Mothers seminars were added to the curriculum. The Helpline began offering services to adoptive parents.

2003 - PACES celebrated its 30th Birthday by offering its first Parent University. The classes focused on learning more about children ages' birth to age 5. The Park Ridge/ Edison region was founded.

PACES has continued to provide quality services and assistance to expectant parents and families of newborn to age 5 children. Some of the many services PACES currently offers:
